The indicator enables international comparisons with the EU and OECD countries.</p> <p><u>Manner of presentation:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- for all levels of education combined</li> <li>- by level of education</li> </ul> <p><u>Unit of measurement:</u> in purchasing power standards (EUR PPS) and as a % of GDP per capita</p>
